## RESTORATION PHASE

(3 years from end of excavation)

- > Return of overburden from storage mound to final void
- > Complete reprofiling of site to restoration contours
- > Establish features such as ponds and watercourses
- > Re-establish the boundary of the former areas of common land
- > Removal of site infrastructure

## AFTERCARE PHASE

(5 years from end of restoration)

- > Continue provision of aftercare including establishment of grass sward, planting of hedgebanks and planting of broadleaf woodland
- > Land Management
- > Habitat Creation
- > Tree Care
- > Rights of Way
